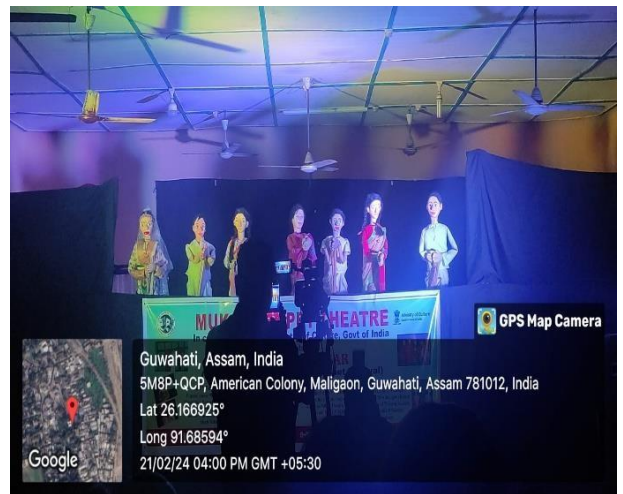
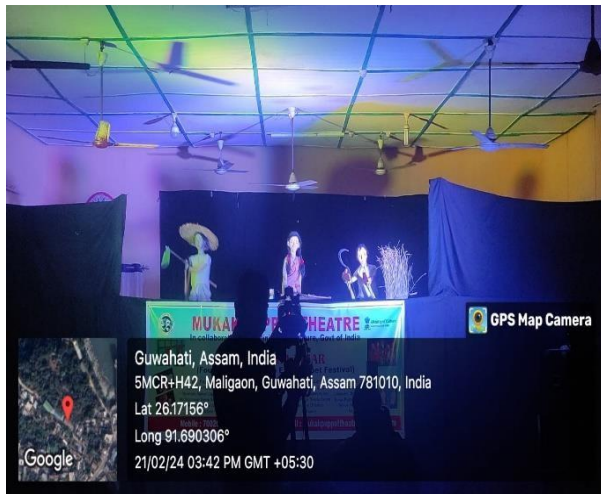
**Cultural Performances: Puppet Show (4 day-long North-East Puppet Festival)**
