HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

With the explosion of media and information spreading technology, the teaching techniques have undergone rapid changes. Besides, the schooling age and period is reduced, for which proper training has become indispensable to handle the well informed pupils. To mitigate the social needs, in order to fill up the gaps of trained teachers and at the same time to provide training facilities to ever growing number of graduates, a vociferous demand for such training facilities was built up in this part of the city.

In response to the demand of Pandu-Maligaon,



Jalukbari, Dharapur, Tetelia, Baragaon, Gotanagar and entire western part of the city this West Guwahati College of Education, in 1992 was established with the relentless efforts of a few devoted academicians

Accordingly, a Sponsoring Body headed by Dr. M. Barthakur, M.A., B.Sc. (Hons), Ph.D., Retd. Professor of Gauhati University and Sri Sreemanta Sarker, M.A., B.Ed., the Principal of Bidyamandir H.S. School as Secretary was formed on 1st April, 1992 to initiate the move for establishing a College of Education i.e., B.Ed. College at Pandu, with permission from Gauhati University. The Sponsoring Body was later on expanded by co-opting other members having selfless love for education and wide experience in socio-administrative activities.

Institution of Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University (KKHSOU) Study Centre came into force due to the tireless effort carried out by Prof. Dr. Minadhar Barthakur, President, WGCE and Dr. Gitanjali Choudhury, Principal, WGCE.

The college has been providing D.El.Ed Regular Course under SCERT with an intake capacity of 50



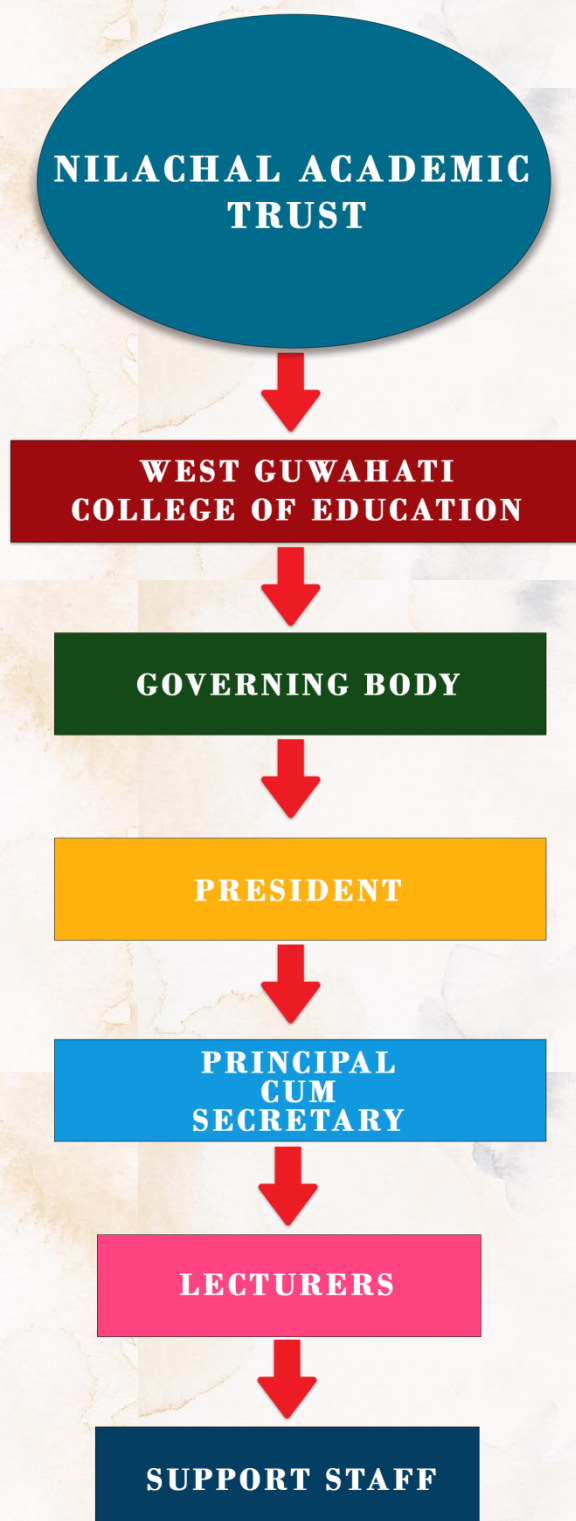
students since 2017 till date.

In the recent years the demand for trained teachers has considerably increased. Due to lack of trained teachers, the State Government deputed teachers for in-service training to limited number of B.T. or B.Ed. degree compulsory for recruitment of teachers. Similarly the state government also prefers trained teachers for appointment in the schools and very likely it will make it statutory requirement for a qualified teacher. Gauhati University abolished the B.T. Department and the existing teachers training colleges failed to meet the demand of ever-growing schools in the nook and corner of the state. As a result, there was a pressing need for a teachers training college in the western part of the city of Guwahati.

The Managing Committee of the Bidyamandir H.S. School of which Sri Sarker was the Secretary was magnanimous enough to permit the Sponsoring Body to start the College in its premises. The efforts of the Sponsoring Body were ultimately crowned with success when “West Guwahati College of Education” (WGCE) was formally inaugurated on the 1st April, 1992 in the premises of Bidyamandir H.S. School, Rest Camp, Pandu, Guwahati-12. It will be unfair if the names of two veteran academicians whose personal efforts and contributions have laid the solid foundation of the College are not mentioned in this context. They are late B.K. Nath, M.Sc.; M.S. (USA) and Mrs. Kamana Barowa, M.A.; B.Ed. Along with the Secretary Sri Sarker, late Mr. Nath as the founder Principal gave the academic shape of the institution by his selfless dedication and Mrs. Kamana Barowa as an experienced teacher organized the academic and co curricular activities. Large number of students from different parts of the city and the state as a whole were attracted and consequently there had been increasing rush for admission in the College. Since 1992, the College has been efficiently functioning and by 2006, it has trained more than 1000 graduates and post graduates to become qualified teachers. The statistics given, testify the creditability of the College.

THE LIBRARY

The library remains open all 365 days. The library has 5200 volumes of books and a number of documents of technical educational and scientific journals. The reference section has variety of books in various disciplines. The SOUL 3.0 is installed to review and relocate the books. Library is well equipped with system software. 60 seats in the reading room are always available for day-to-day utilization by the students and faculty members. Wi-Fi facility is available for teaching staff and student-trainee for Library services.



The Library contributes to the fulfillment of the College mission by:

- ❖ Electing, acquiring, organising, maintaining and making accessible a collection of printed and non-printed, primary and secondary materials that will support the educational, research and public service programmes of both students and the faculty.

- ❖ Responding to the varying needs of the academic community by involving the faculty, the students and the administration in the development and periodic assessment of the library services and resources.

- ❖ Providing an environment conducive to the optimum use of library materials and an appropriate schedule of hours of service and professional assistance.

- ❖ Providing library users with points used in instruction, personal assistance in conducting literature research and other reference services.



PSYCHOLOGICAL LABORATORY

The college facilitates a high quality and advanced psychology laboratory for its students.

The laboratory is fully furnished with modern psychological tools to test the different abilities of students. This new age laboratory gives opportunity to every student to experience every experiment individually. Along with different psychological equipments like Memory Drum, Performance (Bhatiya Battery) test, stop watch etc. It also provides different psychological charts, pictures, models for the benefit of students. This laboratory will help in developing different abilities of the students. It will make the students mentally alert, develop their perception and reasoning ability. It will prepare the students for future challenges of life.

TECHNOLOGY LABORATORY

The College is equipped with well furnished hi-tech equipments which will enable the teacher trainees to be familiar and skilled with new methods and techniques in the instructional process. The equipments being TV, Computer, LCD slide Projector, Overhead Projector, Tape recorder, Radio, Charts, VCR, Educational CDs.

ICT

There is a full-fledged ICT room with more than 25 Number of computers and ample opportunity is offered to the teacher trainees to put on hands on training and to acquaint with fundamental knowledge of computer. The teacher trainees are encouraged to prepare Power Point, Graphical Presentation and MS-Excel tasks.



C-TET & TET COUNSELLING CELL

To enter into today's competitive world, students need to appear for multiple entrance exams, TET is one of them. As the college is a teacher training institute, right guidance from teacher educator can help to revitalize their knowledge and to help the student's to achieve their goals of becoming teacher smoothly. To gain success, it is very important to put every step in the right direction without losing one's focus. Thus our teacher educator can lead the students to right path for appearing the C-TET & TET exam by nurturing during their pre-service journey of these two years through online mode or through hybrid/ blended mode on Sundays and holidays.



SCIENCE LABORATORY

A special body of knowledge- 'Science' is incomplete in itself without having practical knowledge. The class lectures are materialized into practice by performing different practical activities. To provide the theoretical teaching points of Science into practical purpose, the College is equipped with well furnished practical laboratory. The College has all the necessary materials included in Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology within one method 'General Science'.

LANGUAGE LABORATORY

Phonetic is a special feature of our Language Laboratory and this is the only laboratory available in B.Ed. Colleges in Assam. It is a grand success of WCE that the College has also English Language Lab with 10 Computers. The structure, phonetic, accents of the Foreign Language like English is necessary to work in such Language Laboratory to be a professional teacher.

GEOGRAPHY LABORATORY

The miniature World has come to the laboratory of Geography in W.G.C.E. The authority and management has taken a decisive and bold step to introduce Geography as method so that the teacher can be export one to be a successful and trained teacher in Social Studies and Geography teacher.



DRAMA & ART CLUB

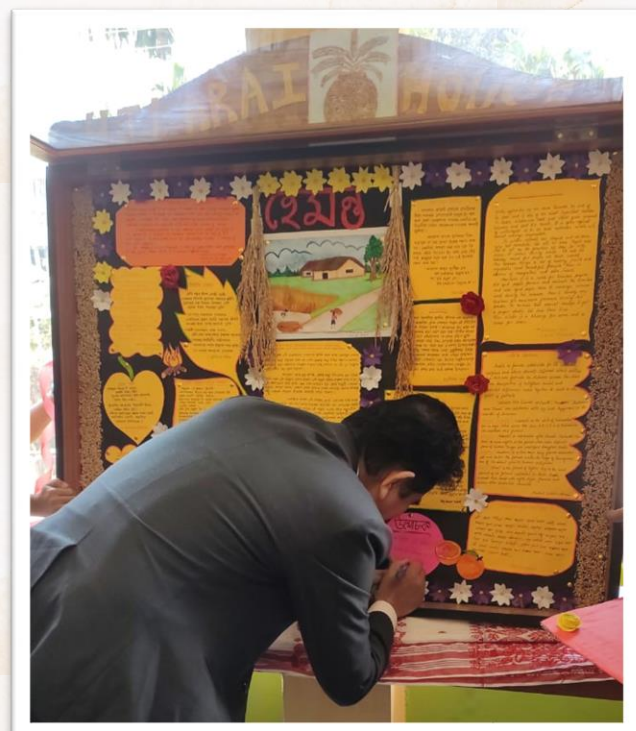


LITERARY CLUB:-

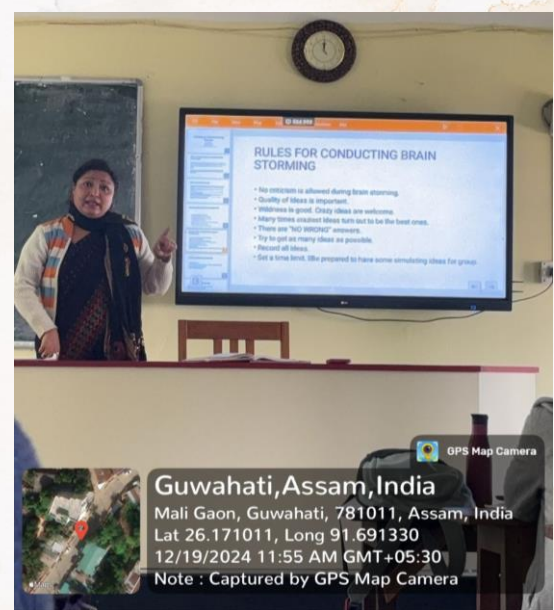

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

TWO YEARS B.ED COURSE:-

The admission procedure starts with Gauhati University notifying for a common entrance test GUBEDCET-2025. From 2025 onwards, Gauhati University has introduced SAMARTH Portal for filling up of online forms and preferred institutions can be selected there itself. Thereafter, the colleges are entitled to prepare the merit list as per the instructions given by the university. The course is both in English and Assamese medium.

- **INTAKE CAPACITY:- 100 Students**

ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR B.ED ADMISSION, AS NOTIFIED BY GAUHATI UNIVERSITY (2025) ARE AS FOLLOWS:-

(As per NCTE norms) A candidate may be allowed to appear in the GUBEDCET-2025 provided that he/she has passed the BA/BSc/B.Com.

Or

MA/M. Sc/M. Com or equivalent degree programme from a recognised Board/University with at least 50% marks (or 45% marks SC/ST/OBC/PWD).

CUT OFF MARKS WILL BE 80 (FOR UNSERVED CATEGORY) AND 60 (FOR RESERVED CATEGORY) CANDIDATES

Merit list will be prepared only on the basis of marks obtained in GUBEDCET-2025. In case of a tie i.e. when two or more candidates obtain equal marks, inter-se merit of such candidates shall be decided as follows:

- **Resolution by finding the ratio of positive marks and negative marks. Candidate having higher absolute value of the ratio will be given better rank.**
- **Resolution by number of unanswered questions. Candidate with less number of unanswered questions will be given better rank.**
- **If the resolution is not possible after this criterion, candidates with higher age will be given better rank.**

Reservation and relaxation policy will be as per existing GU rules.

- **Anything not covered by this guideline will be decided by the University authority at appropriate level.**

TWO YEARS D.EL.ED COURSE:-

West Guwahati College of Education has attained the status of composite one with the introduction of two years D.El.Ed. Course from 2017. Regular D.El.Ed. Course was introduced after obtaining recognition from NCTE and affiliation from SCERT, Government of Assam. The course is both in English and Assamese medium.

The admission procedure starts with SCERT notifying for a common entrance test. The students must appear and qualify the PET Entrance test in order to apply in the desired institution (Students are mapped to the institution by the SCERT itself as per norms). Dates of admission are declared by the SCERT itself in

order to provide the qualified students admission in the institution. The admissions are submitted in the SCERT website during counseling.

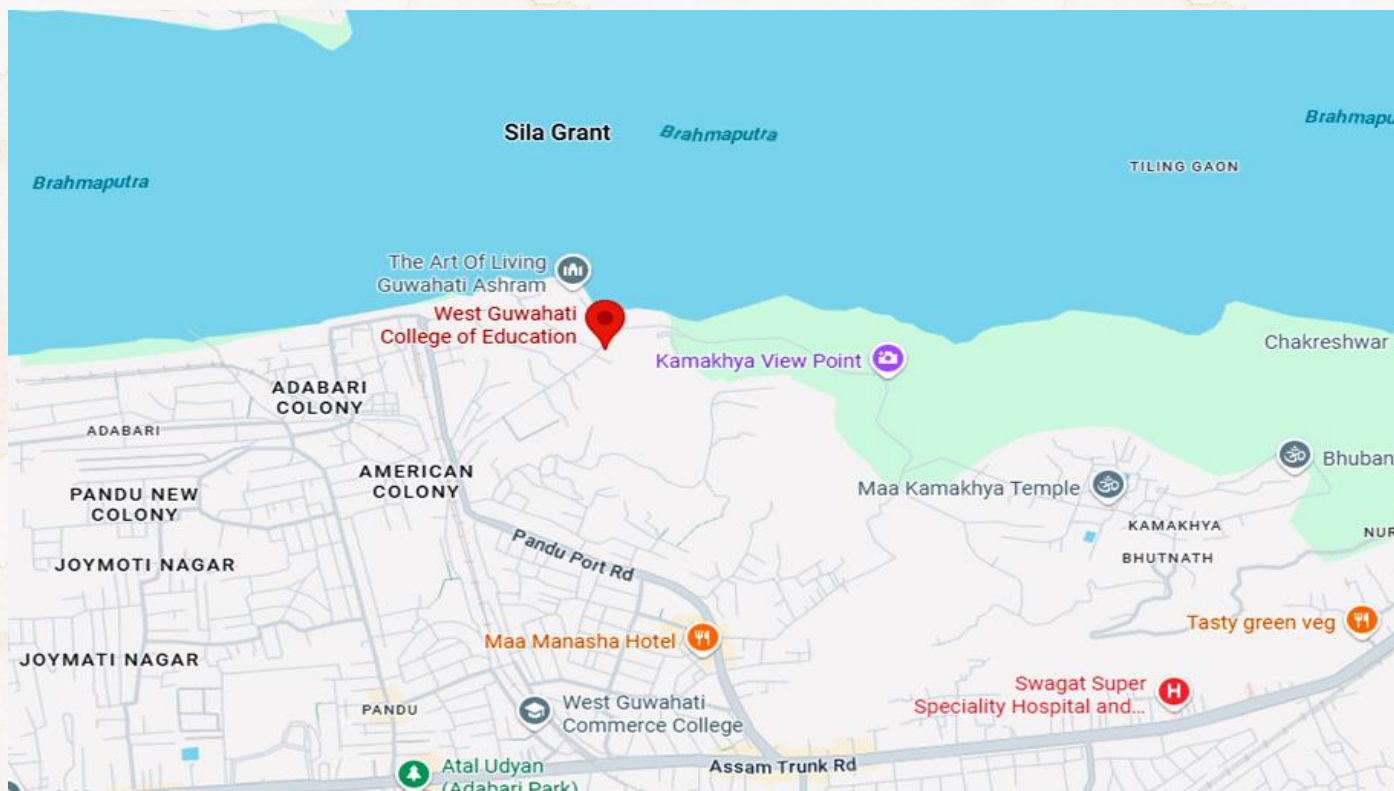
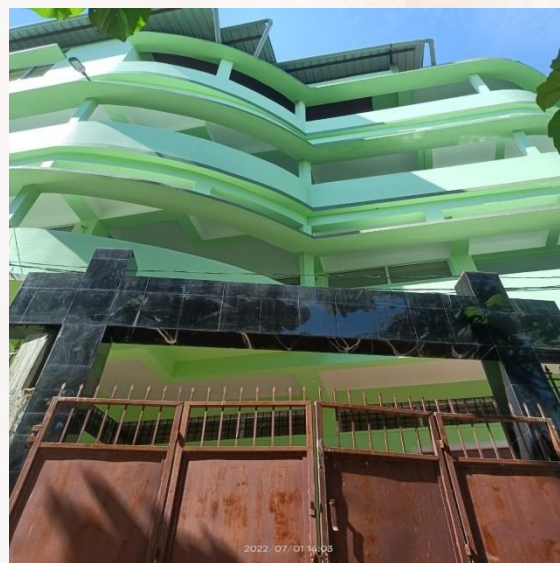
