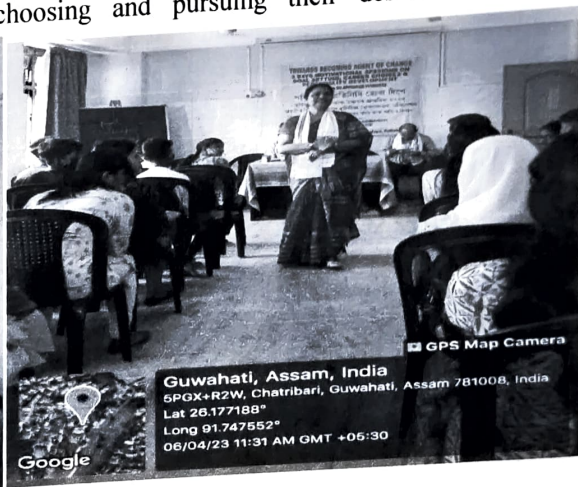
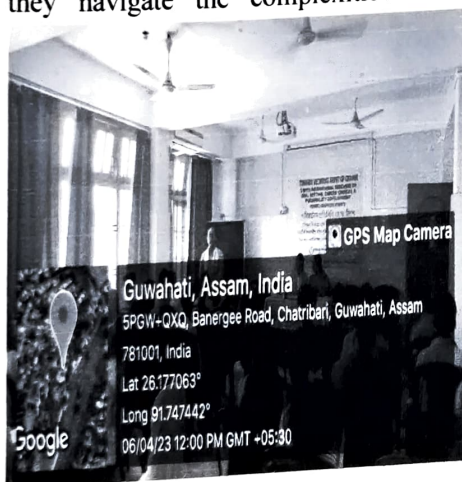

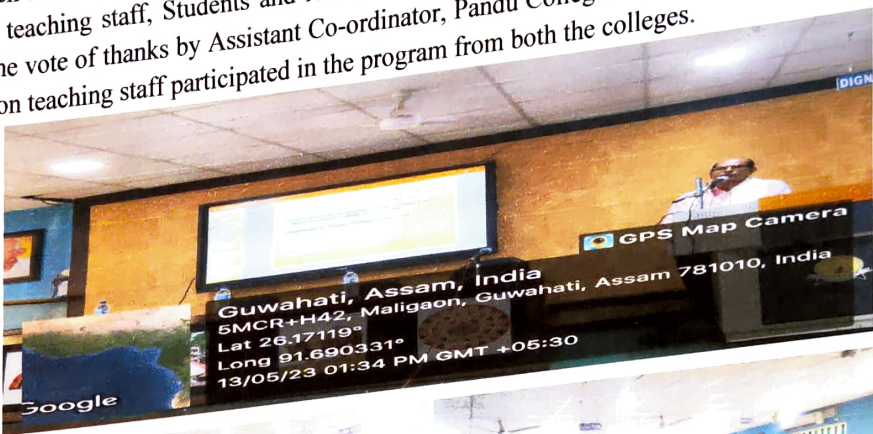

Awareness Campaign on Child Labour

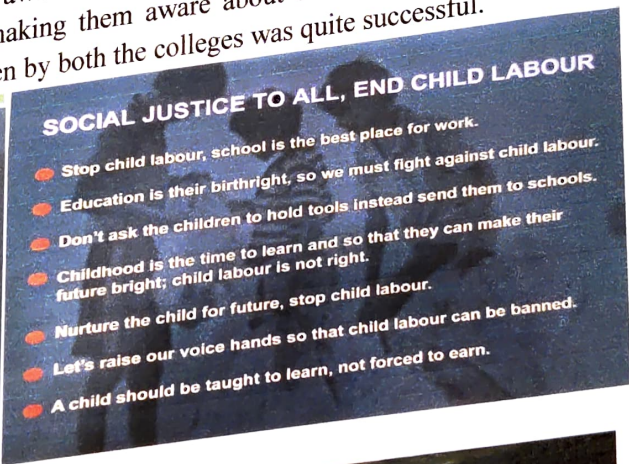
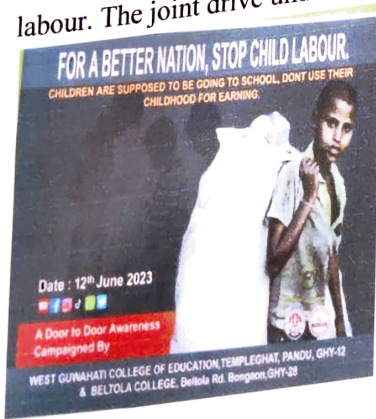
Date- 12th June, 2023

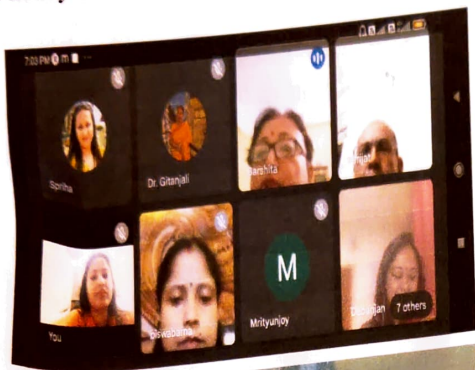

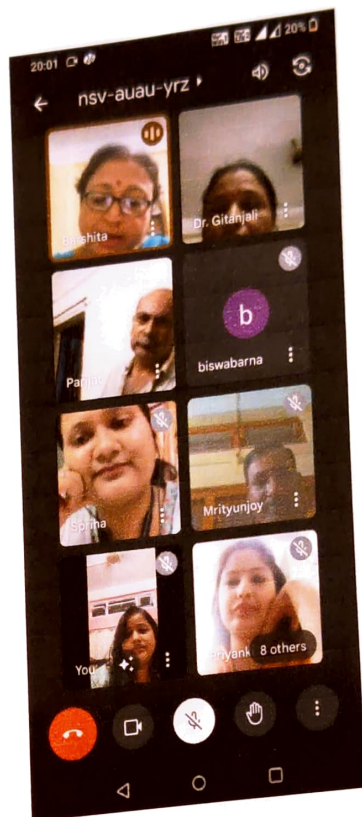

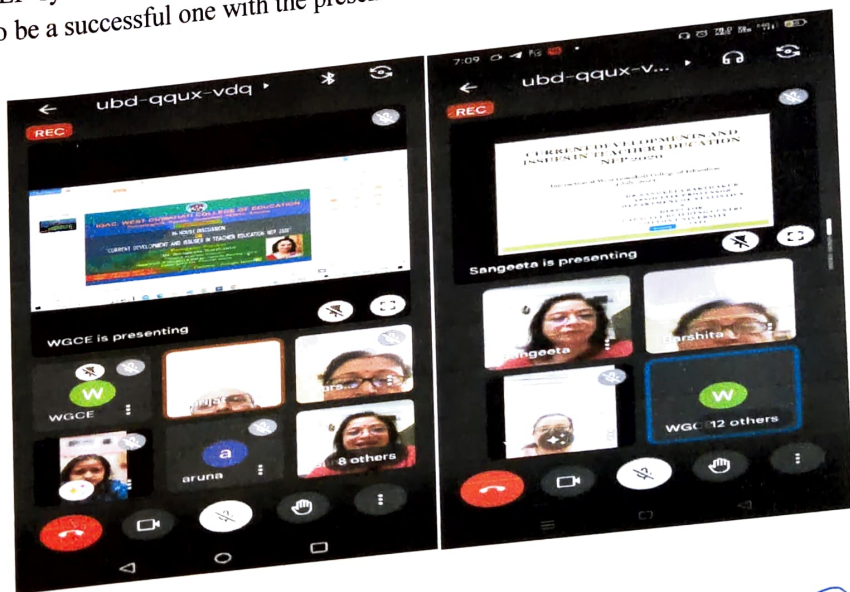

Report on Webinar Current Development and issues in Teacher Education NEP 2020

Date- 4th July, 2023

An In- House discussion was organized by IQAC, WGCE on 4th July, 2023 via Google Meet. The Resource Person of the meeting was Dr. Sangeeta Barthakur, Head & Associate Professor, Department of Statistics & Director, Capacity Building Centre, Cotton University. The topic of discussion was "Current Development & Issues in Teacher Education NEP 2020". She began the session with the description of NEP 2020, the first Education Policy of 21st Century in India under the Chairmanship Dr. Kasturirangan. Next she highlighted on the New Pedagogical and curricular structure where she has mentioned about age, level and stage of children. The principles of NEP 2020 as mentioned by the Government were also discussed. Moreover, NEP 2020 & Teacher Education were highlighted to the utmost along with the major problems and the solutions in the various aspects of the policy. Teachers' recruitment & deployment, Continuous Professional Development: Workshops, Online modules, etc. Mentoring and training of teachers through National Initiative for School Heads' and Teachers' Holistic Advancement (NISHTHA). Career Management and Progression, Professional Standards for Teachers, Approach to Teacher Education, Special shorter Local Teacher education Programmes, B.Ed. Programmes are also to be focused on. She also discussed on National Curriculum Framework (NCFTE) 2009. She also emphasized on encouraging 21st Century Skills in the classrooms, Digital Libraries – to help student trainees in Problem Solving, communication skills, creativity, ethics, etc. She even mentioned about the benefits of teachers in the NEP system. She concluded her session with some definitions of teachers. The session proved to be a successful one with the presence of all the faculty members of WGCE.

 3. Dedication towards his/her profession
 4. Consciousness- About our society, our students socio-economic background, maintain co-operation within the staff enhancing quality education.
 5. Positive Thinking- To be technologically advanced by also accepting the traditional method of learning. To do anything on time in a easy and possible manner so the promptness of the students must be encourage.
 6. Punctuality- Punctuality is not about being on time but basically about respecting your own commitment.
 7. Accountability towards your Profession- Access the feedback of the students after the day's class. Also able to manage the day-to-day things as an administrator systematically. To evaluate every class and to analyze ones teaching on day-to-day basis and this is accountability towards your profession. Various kinds of hurdles that come on the way should not be able to create obstacle in the professional development of the individual.
 8. Motivation is necessary every time by the teacher.
