

The Certificate should indicate the extent (i.e. percentage) of the Physical handicap and it should bear the photograph of the candidate concerned and it should be counter signed by one of the Doctor's constituting the Board issuing the Certificate.



In the event of any doubt either by the authorities or the College as to the genuineness of the Certificate or the extent of the disability of the candidate concerned or in regard to the entitlement of the candidate to seek admission under the category of physically disabled candidates, and if it is found that the candidate is not eligible or entitled under this category, cancel the admission after issuing a show cause notice to the candidate concerned giving him 15 days time to reply.

- **❖** Turn off all the electrical equipments and lights before leaving their classroom.




